## Demand for the Shortening of Business Opening Hours and Suspension of the Serving of alcoholic beverages, etc. to Eating & Drinking Businesses (Period Extension)

<u>XUnderlined</u> portion are points of alteration

- 1. Targeted Areas: All 42 municipalities
- Demand Period: From January 21<sup>st</sup> 2022 (Friday) through <u>March 6<sup>th</sup></u> 2022 (Sunday) [45 days]
  ※ However, it is acceptable to start on January 22<sup>nd</sup> (Saturday),or 23<sup>rd</sup> (Sunday) 2022.
- 3. Demand Contents:
  - Shortening of opening hours to from 5:00AM until 8:00PM
  - No alcoholic beverages (including those brought in by users) shall be served (all day).
  - Avoid eating with more than 5 people in the same group at the same table.
    - X No relaxation of behavioral restrictions afforded by utilizing the vaccine/test package system and the testing of all eligible individuals.
- 4. Targeted Business Types:
  - · Eating & drinking businesses: Eating & drinking businesses (including Izakayas) and cafes etc.
    - (Excluding delivery and takeaway services etc. Wedding halls, etc. are treated the same as eating & drinking businesses.)
  - Entertainment facilities etc.: Bars & karaoke boxes etc. that have received operating permission in accordance with the Food Sanitation Law (excluding facilities that are expected to be used to a considerable extent for the purpose of long-term stays during the night such as internet & manga cafes).
- 5. Compliance Fund
  - The following amount per day per business branch will be paid only if the branch has complied fully with the demand for the entire period.
    - ※ However, the amount to be paid in cases of starting from January 22nd (Saturday) or January 23rd (Sunday) will be for 23 days or 22 days respectively.

For Small & Medium Businesses: 30,000 – 100,000 yen

For Large Businesses (Small & Medium Businesses can also choose this option):

Reduction from average daily sales figure x 0.4 (Maximum: 200,000 yen per day)

- 6. Order/Fine
  - We will begin levying fine procedures (a maximum of 200,000 yen) upon eating and drinking businesses, etc. that do not comply with these demands.
